The Pillars of Faith provides special recognition to those Scouts who took time to earn multiple traditional Catholic religious emblems/recognitions for their program(s) at each age interval. Very few Scouts earn the highest award in their Scouting program; even fewer Scouts earn a religious emblem/recognition; and even less have earned all traditional Catholic religious emblems/recognitions. As this is such a monumental feat; the Archdiocese of Santa Fe Catholic Committee on Scouting offers this unique recognition.

The name and design of this recognition represent the fact that religious emblems/recognitions are like pillars in a building. They support the Scout's development in and appreciation of the Catholic faith. The religious emblems/recognitions are the pillars, not the roof, for none of us are ever done growing in our faith.

To receive this special recognition, the Scout must have earned an emblem/recognition at each of the age levels in the table below. Emblems/recognitions can either be from one organization or mixed from youth organizations as long as the appropriate age level is achieved. Only one emblem/recognition per age level is required. Example: A Scout is eligible if she started in GSUSA and earned the first two age levels then switched registration to Scouting America and earned the other two age levels. So too is a Scout in GSUSA who only earned the GSUSA recognitions.
